

Off Licence (For Remote Sites)

Licence no: 15/OFF/613/2025

Sections 17 to 20, 40 (remote sales) and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (section 40 applies). **Amy's Flowers Ltd** is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises situated at 24 Lincoln Street Frankton Hamilton 3204, and known as "**Amy's Flowers**". And to deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with the Act.

CONDITIONS: This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol will only be sold as part of a gift basket/hamper that contains other non-alcoholic products (no alcohol only sales).
- (b) A limit of one bottle of wine, whiskey, gin, bourbon, vodka, or six-pack of beer/cider per basket or hamper.
- (c) Alcohol must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or any other day between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.
- (d) The licensed premise is described in the plan date stamped as received by the Hamilton District Licensing Committee on 9 June 2025.
- (e) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer and the receiver of an alcohol delivery is not under 18 years of age, and that the receiver (where present) is not intoxicated.
- (f) The outside of the delivery package must contain a label with the following words:
 - CONTAINS ALCOHOL**
 - *Do not leave at destination without proof of delivery.*
 - *Do not deliver to intoxicated persons or persons under 18 years of age.*
- (g) A copy of the licence must be displayed on Amy's Flowers internet site in a prominent place.
- (h) Every receipt for the sale of alcohol by remote sale must contain the licence holder's name, licence number and the date on which the licence expires.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

16th day of July 2028

OR, until the close of the period in which this licence is subsequently renewed.
